* * * GRANT RECEIVED * * *

The Center was awarded a \$10,000 Historic Preservation Fund Matching Grant in aid from the Ohio Historic Preservation Office to survey and inventory structures in Findlay, Ohio's commercial district. The project will be initiated in August, 1983, and will result in a nomination to the National Register of Historic Places. The project is also being locally supported by the Historic Preservation Guild of Hancock County, The Hancock Historical Museum Association, The Findlay Area Arts Council, and The Courier.

* * * OLD YET NEW * * *

Manuscript acquisitions for the 1982/83 year totaled 120. Twenty-two of these collections were from northwest Ohio churches. These collections consist generally of baptismal, confirmation, marriage and death records, pastors registers and minutes, dating as early as the 1820s. Thirty-five collections document women's activities in northwest Ohio especially within clubs and organizations. A few collections noteworthy in their research potential are highlighted below:
