* * * RED AND ROTTING * * *

There are two distinct types of bookbinding leather deterioration: chemical and physical. Physical deterioration is a result of use and improper storage conditions. All leather is "plumped" with oils and fats at the tannery, but these elements disappear in time. Thus, leather needs to be periodically reviled or refurbished. No form of lacquer or varnish should be used on leather bindings. Leather-suede bound volumes cannot be refurbished.

The second form of deterioration is caused by chemicals. Have you ever been in a library, archives, or a county courthouse utilizing old leather bound volumes and discovered that each volume left a light rust-colored powder either on your hands or your clothes? This condition is known as "red rot." Red rot is caused by acid in the leather along with the gases absorbed out of the air. Vegetable-tanned leather was the primary covering material for books until the early 1800's. Therefore, earlier bound volumes seldom show signs of red rot. After the 1830's, chemical tanning methods produced leather in a few days instead of months and consequently resulted in a less durable product. Unfortunately, red rot is irreversible and refurbishing is useless. To provide protection from the air and to give support, a phase box or a book jacket can be custom made to fit the book.

These services are currently available in our conservation laboratory. (\$10.00 per phase box unless oversize, then \$15.00, \$2.00 per book for cloth or leather refurbishing, \$3.00 per polyester book jacket unless oversize, then \$5.00 - every refurbished book should have a jacket made.)
