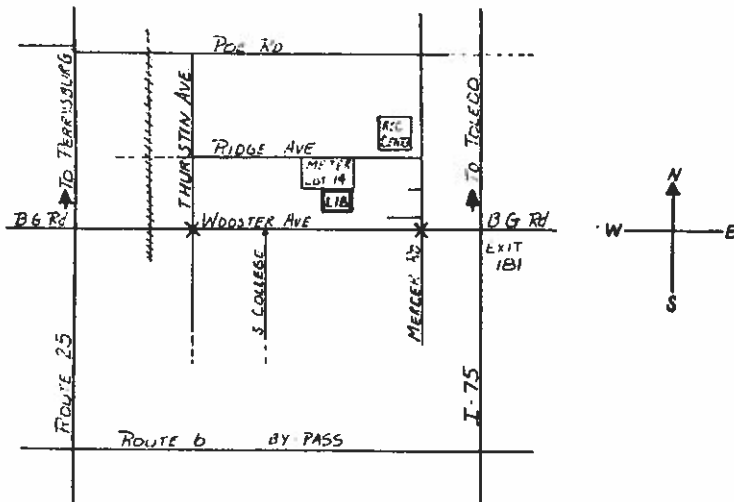
* * * PUBLICATIONS * * *

The Williams County Genealogical Society has reprinted the 1874 and 1894 ATLASSES and 1904 PLAT BOOK of Williams County in one volume. Also included in the book will be the very rare 1864 WALL MAP and a complete index of all the maps and atlases. The book is a 160-page 9x12 hardbound volume which is printed on acid free, non-glare paper. The atlases are \$25.00 if picked up in Bryan or \$28.00 if mailed. The Index may be purchased separately for \$10.00. Mail check or money order to "Atlas Reprint," Williams County Genealogical Society, P.O. Box 293, Bryan, Ohio, 43506.

The Wood County Historical Society has reprinted four atlases (1875, 1875, 1866, 1912) into one volume. The HISTORICAL ATLAS is a hardcover 360-page volume which is completely indexed with over 42,000 references. Maps, statistical information, etchings, and biographical sketches are contained in the reprint. Cost of the volume is \$41.00 if picked up in Bowling Green and \$45.00 if mailed.
