Its goal will be to support teams of innovators working together to conceive, create, develop and refine new products and services that leverage the unique talents inherent to the University.





Our student employees continue to be an integral part of our day-to-day operations and serve as the face of the library on campus. Each year, University Libraries awards competitive scholarships through the UL Student Employee Scholarship Fund.
