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Public Sector Summary

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SUMMARY

An important dimension to improvement of public services is better cooperation and coordination of services offered. There are those who are a part of the public's right and should be provided by tax-based funding. There are others that should be provided by the private sector. If these two sectors are in competition with one another, the result is duplication of services and the general lack of quality. It should be the purpose of the public sector to coordinate, advise and give assistance to the private sector. The public sector in this model is a mediator and provides the necessary leadership role to insure the comprehensive development of leisure resources in the community and actually serves as an aid to stimulate the private sector to fill missing roles. The public and the private sector must be designed in a comprehensive plan to complement each other to provide community services.
