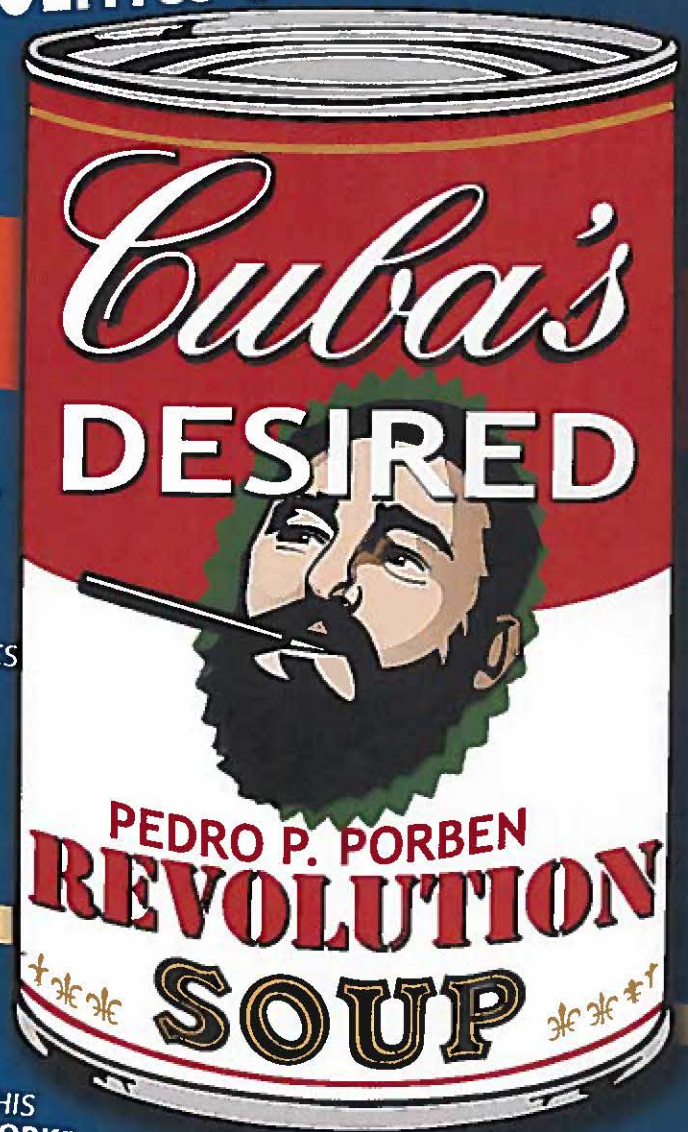
CUBA'S DESIRED REVOLUTION CINEMA AND THE MICRO-POLITICS OF AFFECT

FOR MORE THAN FIVE DECADES, THE ANALYSIS OF THE CUBAN REVOLUTION HAS PRIVILEGED ITS EXPLICITLY POLITICAL DIMENSIONS NEGLECTING THE AFFECTIVE OR WHAT MICHEL FOUCAULT HAS CALLED MICRO-POLITICS. THIS TALK, DRAWING FROM THE WORKS OF **DELEUZE & GUATTARI**, FOCUSES PRECISELY ON THESE MICRO-POLITICS WITHIN THE CUBAN REVOLUTION, EMPHASIZING THE POSITIONAL OR AFFECTIVE CONNECTIONS BETWEEN BODIES (INDIVIDUAL AND COLLECTIVE) THAT MASSIVE SOCIAL AND REVOLUTIONARY CHANGES REQUIRED.

THESE AFFECTIVE CONNECTIONS GENERATE "DESIRING MACHINES" OPERATING THROUGHOUT CULTURAL FIELDS, PRODUCING BODIES AS A COLLECTIVE ASSEMBLAGE, TERRITORIES OR NATIONS. USING SEVERAL SEQUENCES OF MOVIES PRODUCED IN CUBA AFTER 1959, THIS PRESENTATION WILL EXAMINE HOW "DESIRING IMAGES WORK" IN ORDER TO FABRICATE SUCH DESIRING-MACHINES.
