Mr. Bachman moved that the low bids of the Mosser Construction Company for the General Contract (\$69,269.00) and for Alternate G-1 (\$1,900.00), the E. W. File Plumbing and Heating Company for the Plumbing Contract (\$9,472.00) and for the Heating Contract (\$3,700.00), and Elam P. Sabroske for the Electrical Contract (\$3,495.00) be accepted and the State Department of Public Works be asked to enter into contract with the low bidders for the completion of the respective tasks. Mr. Schwyn seconded, all voting "yes" on roll call.

The President read a letter from Mr. Linzell, Director of Public Works, advising us to leave intact the old boilers and chimney until the next heating season be ended. Mr. Reams suggested the President advise Mr. Linzell as to our concern as to the stability of the smoke stack and the danger it presents in case it should fall. He further suggested that Mr. Linzell have one of the men from his office visit Bowling Green, inspect the chimney, and report on the condition of it.
